All-Star Conference

Co-sponsored by the Office of Student Activities and Association of Bentley Activities (ABA), various workshops offer valuable information and access to resources for planning and executing successful programs at Bentley. This conference is typically hosted within the first few weeks of the Fall semester.

Event Lottery

The Cooperative Programming Board (CPB) and Office of Student Activities has a system by which student organizations can reserve dates for future student social events. The event Lottery begins in April for the following fall and spring semesters. CPB facilitates communication with the student organizations and campus constituents that make events happen on campus (i.e. Sodexo Food Service, Facilities, Campus Police, Student Center Event Management Staff, etc.)

Program Planning Assistance

Student organizations plan and execute an incredible amount of programs every semester. The OSA staff is available to meet with student leaders to provide support in negotiating and executing contracts for artist/performers/speakers/vendors invited to provide a service to the Bentley community. Greek Life Program

Bentley boasts a program of 4 nationally recognized sororities who are governed by the Pan-Hellenic council, 2 local fraternities and 5 nationally recognized fraternities, governed by the Interfraternity Council. The Greek Activities Council serves as a programmatic board for the Greek organizations. Men and women involved in Greek life commit themselves to similar tenants supporting leadership, scholarship and service, where philanthropy is integral to their mission. Recruitment occurs in both the fall and spring semesters, and social and service events are planned throughout the year for both Greek and non-Greek community members to attend.
